Q. Cloth Filter - which is inside or outside?

A. The cotton cloth without nap should be outside. When the fluffy nappy part gets wet, coffee is extracted through the fine space in the weave.

Q. Cloth Filter - why do I need to keep it soaked in water?

A. If it is sun-dried after being washed, the coffee ingredients that are absorbed in the flannel oxidize and add unwanted smell to the next brew. It should never be dry if you want to brew delicious coffee. Please wash it carefully after use, put it in water and keep it in a refrigerator.

Q. Cloth Filter - Please let me know when I should change the flannel.

A. There is no fixed maximum use of the flannel because it varies depending on how you use it. As a guideline, we suggest you change it when the inside nap comes off after repeated washing and squeezing or when an extraction time becomes short.

If it is used once a day in an ordinary household, it should probably be changed once a month.

*When it is not used for a long time, put the wet flannel into an airtight bag with a zipper or seal it in a plastic wrap, and store it in a freezer.
