Use classification

All of HARIO's heatproof glass products have a mandatory quality label. They are classified into four groups according to use, i.e., for boiling water, microwave, direct flame, and oven, each needs to be handled differently. When you use them, please check the following mandatory quality labels.

DIRECT FRAME OK	For direct frame Heatproof tempereature 150℃ difference	 When you heat it, remove water drops outside. When additional water is required during cooking, avoid using cold water. Do not use a scouring brush containing abrasive, steel wool, or coarse cleanser. It may suddenly boil and hot water may spurt out. Do not approach too closely while heating. Place it at the center of a heating apparatus and always use a low flame. Do not use this product for purposes other than the designated one.
